Respite Care = Life Saver

Friendly wait staff walk around, refilling drinks and taking orders. Natural light floods the room as patrons are escorted to their respective tables. I'm having the joy of being shown the dining room at Greenwood Village.

I've been touring several facilities lately. I wanted to learn more about the facilities where some of our clients are living. I'm astounded at the luxury. Nursing care is changing.

Similarly, at Magnolia Spring, a new facility in Westfield, the residents dine regularly under clear lights on clean white table cloths with real silverware and china. Every meal is approved by a nutritionist as appropriate for that resident, but the resident still maintains a choice of what they wish to have today.

It really feels like I have walked into a hotel, not an "old folks home." Gone are the sterile brick walls and dingy plastic plates. When I mention this, the director at Greenwood Village thanks me and says it's not the first time someone has made that comment. She then continues to tell me about Respite Care.

Respite Care is still skilled nursing care, but for a short, set period of time. This can be for several months as a resident recovers from a broken bone, or only a

few days as the regular caretaker is out of town.

I have helped many of our clients, who wish to stay at home, but need extra care around the house. Children, grandchildren and in some cases even younger siblings come together to help, but there are times when the primary family caregiver is invited out of town. Sometimes it is to visit a child who is graduating college, other times it may be to visit a serviceman who is on leave, but cannot make it home. Whatever the reason, assisted living facilities have noticed the need for short-term stays. Whatever the reason, having a clean, safe environment with caring, professional people is a life-saver for those needing help.
