What would you like to know about your great-great-grandparents?

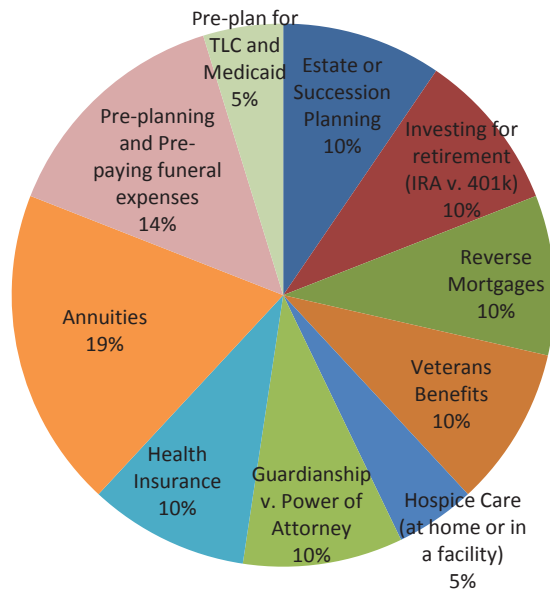

Our next subject will be:

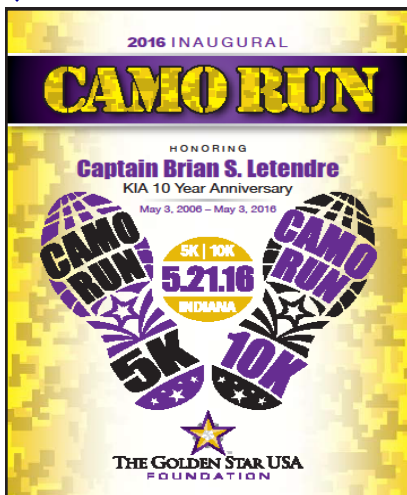
“Guardianship vs Power of Attorney”
